Dear Members

I first tentatively wrote to some members in July about having an EGM. I could have requested this as an MG member and would have been supported in it by at least one fellow member as required - but I thought it more productive and democratic to involve larger numbers of people. I wrote again in more definite terms in end of August and we put four names down (as required if the request is not coming from MG members only) as the required sample - one of whom withdrew - after which I approached MG members.

Thus the sample of four are currently: Henu (ex chair and current MG member), Batya (ex MG member), Christina D (a new member), and Woody (current MG member and trustee of LETSlink UK).

When my first request, supported by the first four, was forwarded to the MG as a whole, the EGM became mandatory as per the Constitution.

Further, many newer members who are fired with enthusiasm for LETS and very keen to get show back on the road - as well as many illustrious long term members of NLLETS (including an ex MG member and appointed officer as well a the oldest member) have indicated - without taking any sides in any disputes - that they agree that in their view EGM is the right way forward - in fact one of them is strongly advocating for consensus as the decision making process for this meeting.
