

NLLETS /CamdenLETS Management Meeting

Present: Mardi (chair), Mary (secretary)

We looked at the lists of members in the CES (66 active accounts), which had been derived from the Local Exchange system, still showing (211 active accounts - 986 including inactive accounts). Due to the low levels of activity once the CES system had been installed about 4 years ago, it would be possible to update the older system and reinstate it.

Updating: Personal details can be updated on old system from the CES. A balancing transaction can be created to deal with discrepancies in pledge balance. If a "sub due" field is added on the old system, the accounts of those on CES can be shown with the relevant due date.

So far we have not been able to see any data about sterling subscriptions. If we were going to offer to reinstate old accounts, we could contribute pledges from an admin account. Or we could work out a formula such as free to join Londonwide or borough-wide LETS and pay pledges or links in lieu, but we are not too concerned about sterling money, as it causes complications every time we try to deal with it.

We need to get in touch with old committee members, e.g. Elizabeth Hanss, Lucia Kagiso, Mary Herivel, Claire Hardiman, Alex, Mark, and see how others feel about steps to get LETS moving again, and Mardi would contact these individuals and arrange a follow-up meeting. Mary had already decided that we need to rotate into different venues.
